 - b. Have completed the equivalent of one semester of college work
 - c. Be attending or have been accepted for the 2024 fall term at an accredited two- or four-year institution, advanced degree program or vocational school
- 3. Scholarship award is based on the following criteria (not necessary in order of importance):
 - a. Demonstrated financial need
 - b. Academic record
 - c. One (1) character reference from non-family member, mentor, or friend.
- 4. As part of the process, each applicant may be asked to meet the Scholarship Committee for an informal interview. The applicant will be contacted to arrange a convenient time and place.
